

NOTICE TO TRAVELLERS CARRYING PLANTS







A bacterium, *Xylella fastidiosa*, currently present in Italy, causes a deadly disease on olive trees, oleander, prunus, vines, citrus... Vectored by insects, the disease can also affect many ornamental plants.

TRAVELLER'S ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE PROHIBITION OF BRINGING 200 SPECIES OF PLANTS INTO CORSICA

Intensified disembarkation screenings are planned to verify compliance with the ban.

IN CASE OF VIOLATION, THE PLANTS WILL BE CONFISCATED AND DESTROYED

PENALTIES OF UP TO TWO YEARS IMPRISONMENT AND 300 000 €
FINE WILL BE APPLIED
